We travel through Iron Knob to Kimba where we enjoy our lunch. Our afternoon is spent on the coach as we travel to the picturesque coastal town of Streaky Bay.

At Ellison we have a guided town tour and enjoy a BBQ lunch. We travel to the bottom of the peninsula and the town of Port Lincoln. This town is home to the country's largest commercial fishing fleet and has spectacular coastal views and amazing native wildlife.

Day 7 — Saturday 21 August F

Port Lincoln

We drive along Whalers Way, privately owned land on the tip of the Southern Eyre Peninsula. We see amazing views from the very tip of the Eyre Peninsula. Returning to town we have lunch at the Marina Hotel before joining Adventure Bay Charters to cruise one of the world's largest protected natural harbours, Boston Bay. We cruise the magnificent waters and also indulge in a tasting of the wonderful local seafood.

Our visit is enhanced by a guided walking tour with the opportunity to involve ourselves in the garden's features. York Peninsula

Today we spend time in three towns – Kadina, Moonta and Wallaroo, collectively known as the "Copper Triangle". In Kadina we visit the Farm Shed Museum and Tourist Centre to uncover the discovery of minerals that put Yorke Peninsula on the world map. "Kadina's Story" is a photographic display depicting the history of the Peninsula's largest and most important town and the agricultural display tells of the evolution of farm machinery which forms the basis of the National Dryland Farming Interpretive Centre. Next, we visit Moonta, known as Australia's little Cornwall. Copper was discovered here in 1861 attracting many Cornish miners and their centuries old mining methods. At the Moonta Mines Museum we'll board the Tourist Railway which departs from a station just outside the museum. Relive life in Moonta as we pass the historic landmarks of the former mining operations, including the reservoir and tunnel within Ryans Tailings Heap. Port Pirie to Adelaide

A member of the family will give us a wonderful insight into nineteenth century station life with a guided tour and delicious lunch. We stop in at Paulett Wines for a delightful tasting before expressing to Adelaide.
